Its laser energy penetrates deeply into the skin, generating heat around the sebaceous glands. The heat reduces sebum output, suppresses inflammation, and destroys the P. acnes bacteria. Shortly after the treatment, you should start to see a reduction in swelling, and the overall number of acne lesions should decrease.


Aerolase lasers use a uniquely gentle and versatile laser technology, which safely and effectively treats all types of acne, including:


As an added bonus, the laser also treat areas of concern such as:

Dead skin cells and excess sebum cause pores to become blocked. Bacteria builds up causing infection, resulting in acne.



Energy from the laser heats the tissue resulting in reduced sebum output, suppression of inflammation, and destruction of the p.acnes bacteria colony.



After treatment, the pore is unblocked. New collagen starts to form, resulting in clearer and smoother skin. There is less inflammation and skin is less oily.
